



MARINE CORPS EDUCATIONAL FUNDING

If you are looking to enhance your legal education after earning your commission as a Marine Officer, you may apply to one of the educational funding programs below:

FULLY FUNDED EDUCATION PROGRAMS

- Judge Advocate Officer Graduate Courses (Master of Laws)
 - Judge Advocate General's School, U.S. Army, Charlottesville, VA
 - Contract and Procurement Law
 - International & Operational Law
 - Military Justice
- Special Education Program (Master of Laws)
 - Any civilian law school
 - Environmental Law
 - International Law
 - Labor Law



SELF-FUNDED EDUCATION

- Master of Laws from any civilian law school
 - Marine Officers may request to attend a civilian LLM program before reporting to The Basic School (TBS) or after their first tour.
- State or Federal Clerkships
 - Marine Officers offered a state or federal clerkship may request a deferral before reporting to TBS.

DEBT AND EDUCATION INCENTIVES

- Post-9/11 G.I. Bill
 - Pays for an advanced degree (up to the maximum in-state undergraduate tuition and fees at an accredited public college).
 - Complete forgiveness of any remaining debt after 10 years of public service.
- College Cost Reduction and Access Act
 - Income-based reduction of monthly payments on federal student loans.
 - Complete forgiveness of any remaining federal loan debt after 10 years of public service.
- Law School Education Debt Subsidy
 - \$45,000 in additional compensation paid in \$15,000 yearly increments during a Marine Officer's second tour.
